Committee on Judiciary.

HB18-1409 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 10, after line 4 insert:

2 "SECTION 6. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-32-120, amend
3 (5)(c) as follows:

4 24-32-120. Justice reinvestment crime prevention initiative -
5 program - rules - reports - repeal. (5) (c) ~~The state treasurer shall~~
6 ~~transfer any unexpended and unencumbered money remaining in the fund~~
7 ~~at the end of a fiscal year to the general fund~~ NOTWITHSTANDING THE
8 PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTIONS (5)(d) AND (5)(e) OF THIS SECTION AND
9 SUBJECT TO ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, THE
10 DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT MAY EXPEND MONEY
11 FROM THE FUND TO IMPLEMENT HOUSE BILL 18-1409, ENACTED IN 2018.
12 ANY UNEXPENDED AND UNENCUMBERED MONEY FROM AN APPROPRIATION
13 MADE PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION (5)(c) REMAINS AVAILABLE FOR
14 EXPENDITURE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT
15 IN THE NEXT FISCAL YEAR WITHOUT FURTHER APPROPRIATION.

16 SECTION 7. Appropriation. For the 2018-19 state fiscal year,
17 \$1,761,140 is appropriated to the department of public health and
18 environment. This appropriation is from the parole savings fund created
19 in section 24-32-120, C.R.S., and is based on an assumption that the
20 department will require an additional 0.5 FTE. To implement this act, the
21 department may use this appropriation for funding to eligible entities that
22 provide support services to crime survivors and other interventions that
23 are intended to reduce repeat victimization. Any money appropriated in
24 this section not expended prior to July 1, 2019, is further appropriated to
25 the department of public health and environment for 2019-20 state fiscal
26 year for the same purpose."

27 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

28 Page 1, line 104, strike "OFFENDERS." and substitute "OFFENDERS AND
29 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION."
