SENATE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on State, Veterans, & Military Affairs.

HB16-1368 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 18, line 11, after "board." insert "(1)".

2 Page 18, strike lines 14 through 18 and substitute "PRESERVATION OF
3 RECORDS. IF THE STATE ARCHIVIST CONVENES THE BOARD, THE STATE
4 ARCHIVIST SHALL ENSURE THAT TECHNICAL EXPERTS FROM THE
5 FOLLOWING GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES AND NONPROFIT ENTITIES HAVE AN
6 OPPORTUNITY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE WORK OF THE BOARD:

7 (a) EXECUTIVE BRANCH AGENCIES UNDER THE GOVERNOR'S
8 PURVIEW;

9 (b) THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL;

10 (c) THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE;

11 (d) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY;

12 (e) THE JUDICIAL BRANCH;

13 (f) A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION THAT REPRESENTS COUNTIES AND
14 A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION THAT REPRESENTS COUNTY CLERKS;

15 (g) A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION THAT REPRESENTS
16 MUNICIPALITIES AND A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION THAT REPRESENTS
17 MUNICIPAL CLERKS; AND

18 (h) A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION THAT REPRESENTS SPECIAL
19 DISTRICTS.

20 (2) EACH GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY AND NONPROFIT ENTITY THAT
21 IS ASKED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE RECORDS ADVISORY BOARD PURSUANT
22 TO SUBSECTION (1) OF THIS SECTION SHALL DESIGNATE THE APPROPRIATE
23 PERSON FROM THE AGENCY OR ENTITY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE WORK OF
24 THE BOARD.

25 (3) IF THE STATE ARCHIVIST CONVENES A RECORDS ADVISORY
26 BOARD, THE BOARD SHALL HAVE THE FOLLOWING GOALS:

27 (a) IDENTIFY, RESEARCH, AND PRIORITIZE RECORDS MANAGEMENT,
28 PRESERVATION, AND ACCESS PROBLEMS;

29 (b) ASSIST IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF RECORDS MANAGEMENT
30 POLICIES AND PROCEDURES;

31 (c) COLLECT AND SHARE ACCEPTED PRESERVATION AND ARCHIVAL
32 BEST PRACTICES;

33 (d) ASSIST IN THE APPRAISAL OF RECORDS FOR HISTORICAL VALUE;

34 (e) REVIEW RECORDS RETENTION SCHEDULES; AND

35 (f) STUDY AND DEVELOP STANDARDS AND MANAGEMENT
36 PROGRAMS TO ADDRESS THE CREATION, MAINTENANCE, ARCHIVING, AND
37 ACCESS OF PERMANENT DIGITAL RECORDS."

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
