Restraining orders against children of parents ~~who are kept~~ in an assisted living ~~center~~, is emotional abuse. Restraining orders are ~~not only~~ punitive to the adult child, ~~but also to the~~ elder parent. Simply stated, denial of family visitation with an elder is *Elder Abuse*.

Emma Parr suffered not only physical abuse, but from mental anguish ~~as well~~.

Emma Parr, was forced to live in ~~an~~ assisted living ~~facility~~ by ~~the authority of~~ the court. ~~It had~~ *planned* ~~always been the intention of~~ her son, Larry Parr, to care for her in his home in her later stages of life ~~when she could no longer care for herself~~ and in preparation ~~he~~ remodeled his house to A.D.A. compliance.

Emma Parr was forced to endure ~~deplorable and inhumane living conditions including~~ chemical restraints, malnutrition, ~~and~~ hunger, dehydration, inadequate clothing, assault, and sanitary issues, all under the approval of the court appointed Guardian even though he wrote Larry saying, "~~As I have also told you, Mr. Parr,~~" I too feel ~~that~~ Emma needs more care."

In April, 2011, Larry filed a grievance against the court-appointed guardian, with D.O.R.A. and Denver Department of Health. The guardian hired an attorney to defend himself ~~against his lack of fiduciary duty~~

and both, he and his attorney, ~~unethically~~ charged Emma Parr's estate tens of thousands of dollars, ~~when his defense did not benefit Emma Parr in any way.~~

The Denver Department of Health made an unannounced inspection of the assisted living center ~~in which she resided~~ on April 5, 2011, and cited them for six infractions.

In the early morning of the next day, Emma Parr suffered a horrible blow that left both eyes black and blue and swollen.

After Larry called the Denver Police, Emma Parr told Officer Padilla, "I think someone hit me." A staff member concurred saying, "She got hit by a blunt instrument." Proof exists as this statement was ~~openly tape~~ recorded.

After that, Larry was ~~constantly~~ shadowed by a staff member ~~when~~ during ~~his~~ visits with Emma Parr.

Verifying
The Guardian and his attorney, had a temporary restraining put on Larry to ~~severely limit his~~ ~~visitation with the observance of~~ a private detective at a cost of over \$30,000 ~~charged~~ to Emma Parr's estate.

Before Larry filed his grievance with D.O.R.A. in April, 2011, there had never been ~~any~~ questions ~~or~~ ~~problems~~ with ~~his~~ visitation and ~~certainly~~ no ~~one~~ questioned ~~the~~ care of and behavior with Emma Parr.

Larry asked friends to visit Emma Parr in his place. All of these visitors were denied visitation ~~under~~ ~~by~~ ~~directives~~ of the Guardian and ~~the~~ director, on the grounds they caused her harm. Consequently, Emma Parr lived in near total isolation.

Emma and Larry were denied the human joy of being together ~~on~~ holidays, Christmas, Mother's Day and her birthday. While other families gathered around their loved ones at the assisted living center, Emma Parr sat alone in a wheelchair in her room. Emma Parr was denied Larry's gentle touch, the sound of his voice, the warmth of his kiss on her cheek and the comfort of hearing the words, "I love you."
