Fiscal Note Memorandum

TO: Members of the Senate Health and Human Services Committee
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Fiscal Assessment of L.003 to SB 26-032

This memorandum is an assessment of the fiscal impact of the attached proposed amendment L.003 to Senate Bill 26-032. This fiscal assessment is for the impact of the bill with inclusion of this amendment only. Any other added amendment could influence the fiscal impact.

Summary of Proposed Amendment

Amendment L.003 eliminates the provision of the bill giving pharmacist independent prescribing authority for vaccines.

Fiscal Impact of Amendment

The bill eliminates the costs in the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing (HCPF) to shown in the initial fiscal note published on January 28, 2026.

Bill's Revised Fiscal Impact with Amendment

With Amendment L.003, the bill increases workload for several state agencies, as described in the initial fiscal note. No appropriation is required to any state agency.
