PART 1

Purpose AI usage in okay in healthcare!

Our aim is to ensure patient rights are being upheld through a disclosure requirement in psychotherapy services (not for billing or routine admin usage) and if insurance denies coverage the final decision needs to be reviewed and approved by a qualified human - not solely an AI system.

PART 2

Guardrails for AI usage

1. Patient- Focused: Consent in psychotherapy
 - a. Patients must know that an AI system is being used by their provider if at all (admin tasks excluded).
2. Patient-Focused: AI in Psychotherapy & (no) Payment
 - a. If an AI system is used as part of the psychotherapy process, the patient cannot be billed for it.
3. Industry-Focused: AI usage in the claims process
 - a. AI can be used but the AI system must take into account the person's medical record and not solely off of group data. A person's data must not be used beyond its intended purpose (of informing coverage)
 - b. If an AI System recommends a denial of coverage, a qualified human must review the decision.
