AN ACT

CONCERNING THE CONTINUATION OF THE COLORADO HEALTH SERVICE CORPS ADVISORY COUNCIL.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-1.5-504, **repeal** (6) as follows:

- 25-1.5-504. Colorado health service corps advisory council creation membership duties. (6) (a) This section is repealed, effective July 1, 2017.
- (b) Prior to said repeal, the advisory council shall be reviewed as provided for in section 2-3-1203, C.R.S.
- **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, **repeal** (4)(a)(VI) as follows:
- **2-3-1203.** Sunset review of advisory committees legislative declaration definition repeal. (4) (a) The following statutory authorizations for the designated advisory committees will repeal on July 1, 2017:
- (VI) The Colorado health service corps advisory council created in section 25-1.5-504, C.R.S.;
- **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
