## SENATE BILL 17-218

## AN ACT

CONCERNING THE CONTINUATION OF THE REGULATION OF LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTS BY THE  
DIVISION OF PROFESSIONS AND OCCUPATIONS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF REGULATORY AGENCIES.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

**SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **amend** 12-45-120 as follows:

**12-45-120. Repeal of article.** This ~~article~~ ARTICLE 45 is repealed, effective ~~July 1, 2017.~~ ~~Prior to such~~ SEPTEMBER 1, 2028. BEFORE ITS repeal, the licensing of landscape architects by the board ~~shall be reviewed as provided in~~ IS SCHEDULED FOR REVIEW IN ACCORDANCE WITH section 24-34-104. ~~C.R.S.~~

**SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-34-104, **repeal** (12)(a)(I); and **add** (29) as follows:

**24-34-104. General assembly review of regulatory agencies and functions for repeal, continuation, or reestablishment - legislative declaration - repeal.**  
(12) (a) The following agencies, functions, or both, will repeal on July 1, 2017:

(I) ~~The licensing of landscape architects and the Colorado state board of landscape architects in the department of regulatory agencies in accordance with article 45 of title 12, C.R.S.;~~

(29) (a) THE FOLLOWING AGENCIES, FUNCTIONS, OR BOTH, WILL REPEAL ON SEPTEMBER 1, 2028:

(I) THE LICENSING OF LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 45 OF TITLE 12.

(b) THIS SUBSECTION (29) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 1, 2030.

**SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
