## PROFESSIONS AND OCCUPATIONS

## AN ACT

CONCERNING THE CONTINUATION OF THE REGULATION OF LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTS BY THE DIVISION OF PROFESSIONS AND OCCUPATIONS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF REGULATORY AGENCIES.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

**SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **amend** 12-45-120 as follows:

**12-45-120. Repeal of article.** This article ARTICLE 45 is repealed, effective July 1, 2017. Prior to such September 1, 2028. Before its repeal, the licensing of landscape architects by the board shall be reviewed as provided in is scheduled for review in Accordance with section 24-34-104. C.R.S.

**SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-34-104, **repeal** (12)(a)(I); and **add** (29) as follows:

- **24-34-104.** General assembly review of regulatory agencies and functions for repeal, continuation, or reestablishment legislative declaration repeal. (12) (a) The following agencies, functions, or both, will repeal on July 1, 2017:
- (I) The licensing of landscape architects and the Colorado state board of landscape architects in the department of regulatory agencies in accordance with article 45 of title 12, C.R.S.;
- (29) (a) The following agencies, functions, or both, will repeal on September 1, 2028:
- (I) THE LICENSING OF LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 45 OF TITLE 12.

Capital letters indicate new material added to existing statutes; dashes through words indicate deletions from existing statutes and such material not part of act.

(b) This subsection (29) is repealed, effective September 1, 2030.

**SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
