AN ACT

CONCERNING THE CONTINUATION OF THE COURT SECURITY CASH FUND COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, **repeal** 13-1-206.

SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, **repeal** (4)(a)(V) as follows:

- **2-3-1203.** Sunset review of advisory committees legislative declaration definition repeal. (4) (a) The following statutory authorizations for the designated advisory committees will repeal on July 1, 2017:
- (V) The court security cash fund commission created in part 2 of article 1 of title 13, C.R.S.;

SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
