CONCERNING THE REPEAL OF THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF MARIJUANA COORDINATION.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, **repeal** article 38.3 of title 24.

SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-3.5-1006, **amend** (1) as follows:

25-3.5-1006. Align marijuana messaging - integration of information across state agencies. (1) The division shall integrate information from each state agency involved in providing retail marijuana information, including the department of human services, ~~the governor's office of marijuana coordination~~; the department of transportation, the department of revenue, the department of law, the department of public safety, and the department of education, to align the messaging, branding,

and education provided by each agency for the eighteen-month public education and awareness campaign required pursuant to section 25-3.5-1003, the ongoing prevention and education campaign required pursuant to section 25-3.5-1004, and the website required pursuant to section 25-3.5-1005.

SECTION 3. Effective date. This act takes effect July 1, 2017.

SECTION 4. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,

determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
