After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB18-1130 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, strike everything below the enacting clause and  
2 substitute:

3 "SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-60.5-201, **amend**  
4 (3)(b)(I)(B) as follows:

5 **22-60.5-201. Types of teacher licenses issued - term - definition**  
6 **- rules.** (3) (b) (I) The department of education may issue a professional  
7 teacher license to any applicant from another state if:

8 (B) The applicant has had at least three years of ~~continuous~~,  
9 successful, evaluated experience WITHIN THE PREVIOUS SEVEN YEARS as  
10 a teacher in an established elementary or secondary school and can  
11 provide documentation of such experience on forms provided by the  
12 department.

13 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-60.5-210, **amend**  
14 (3)(b)(I)(B) as follows:

15 **22-60.5-210. Types of special services licenses issued - term -**  
16 **definition.** (3) (b) (I) The department of education may issue a  
17 professional special services license to any applicant from another state  
18 if:

19 (B) The applicant has had at least three years of ~~continuous~~,  
20 successful, evaluated experience WITHIN THE PREVIOUS SEVEN YEARS as  
21 a special services provider in an established elementary or secondary  
22 school and can provide documentation of such experience on forms  
23 provided by the department.

1           **SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act  
2 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the  
3 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August  
4 8, 2018, if adjournment sine die is on May 9, 2018); except that, if a  
5 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the  
6 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act  
7 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect  
8 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in  
9 November 2018 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the  
10 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor."

11 Page1 of the printed bill, strike line 102 and substitute "**PERSONNEL WHO**  
12 **ARE LICENSED IN ANOTHER STATE TO TEACH IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS.**".

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
