To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation as follows: (a) \$621,070 which consists of \$396,070 from general fund and \$225,000 from the opiate antagonist bulk purchase fund, for use by the prevention services division for administration, which amount is based on an assumption that the department will require an additional 1.8 FTE; and (b) \$38,402 from general fund for the household take-back medication program, which amount is based on an assumption that the department will require an additional 0.4 FTE."
