

## HOUSE BILL 21-1138

BY REPRESENTATIVE(S) McLachlan and Catlin, Amabile, Arndt, Bird, Cutter, Duran, Esgar, Exum, Gray, Snyder, Titone, Valdez D.; also SENATOR(S) Hisey, Holbert, Moreno.

CONCERNING CLARIFYING RESTRICTIONS ON THE OPERATION OF OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

**SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 33-14.5-108, amend (1) introductory portion as follows:

33-14.5-108. Off-highway vehicle operation prohibited on streets, roads, and highways. (1) No It is unlawful to operate an off-highway vehicle may be operated on the public streets, roads, or highways of this state, regardless of the state or other jurisdiction in which the off-highway vehicle is registered or titled, except in the following cases:

**SECTION 2.** Applicability. This act applies to conduct occurring before, on, or after the effective date of this act.

Capital letters or bold & italic numbers indicate new material added to existing law; dashes through words or numbers indicate deletions from existing law and such material is not part of the act.

**SECTION 3.** Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
