After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB21-1226 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 3, strike line 19 and substitute "(1)(c), (1)(d),
2 and (2)(a) introductory portion; and **add** (1)(e) and (2)(a.5) as follows:".

3 Page 4, after line 3 insert:

4 "(2) (a) A person who knowingly or willfully violates ~~subsection~~
5 ~~(1)~~ ANY OF THE PROVISIONS IN SUBSECTIONS (1)(a) TO (1)(d) of this
6 section:

7 (a.5) A PERSON WHO KNOWINGLY OR WILLFULLY VIOLATES
8 SUBSECTION (1)(e) OF THIS SECTION COMMITS A CIVIL INFRACTION AND,
9 UPON ENTRY OF JUDGMENT, SHALL BE FINED ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS.
10 WHEN A PERSON IS CHARGED WITH KNOWINGLY OR WILLFULLY VIOLATING
11 SUBSECTION (1)(e) OF THIS SECTION, THE OFFICER SHALL GIVE A PENALTY
12 ASSESSMENT NOTICE TO THE DEFENDANT AND FOLLOW THE PROCEDURES
13 IN SECTION 33-15-102 (2). IF THE FINE AND SURCHARGE ARE NOT TIMELY
14 PAID, THE CASE SHALL BE HEARD IN THE COURT OF COMPETENT
15 JURISDICTION PRESCRIBED ON THE PENALTY ASSESSMENT NOTICE IN THE
16 MANNER PROVIDED FOR IN ARTICLE 4 OF TITLE 42 FOR THE PROSECUTION
17 OF TRAFFIC INFRACTIONS."
