Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB21-1266 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 14, before line 4 insert:

2 **"SECTION 7. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2021-22 state fiscal
3 year, \$456,090 is appropriated to the department of public health and
4 environment. This appropriation is from the general fund. To implement
5 this act, the department may use this appropriation as follows:

6 (a) \$196,032 for use by the air pollution control division for
7 personal services related to stationary sources, which amount is based on
8 an assumption that the division will require an additional 2.7 FTE;

9 (b) \$153,718 for use by the air pollution control division for
10 operating costs related to stationary sources; and

11 (c) \$106,340 for the purchase of legal services.

12 (2) For the 2021-22 state fiscal year, \$106,340 is appropriated to
13 the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds
14 received from the department of public health and environment under
15 subsection (1)(c) of this section and is based on an assumption that the
16 department of law will require an additional 0.5 FTE. To implement this
17 act, the department of law may use this appropriation to provide legal
18 services for the department of public health and environment."

19 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

20 Page 1, line 102, strike "COMMUNITIES." and substitute "COMMUNITIES,
21 AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION."
