Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB21-200 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 22, after line 20 insert:

2 "SECTION 7. **Appropriation.** (1) For the 2021-22 state fiscal  
3 year, \$1,132,993 is appropriated to the department of public health and  
4 environment for use by administration and support. This appropriation is  
5 from the general fund. To implement this act, the division may use this  
6 appropriation as follows:

7 (a) \$332,482 for health, life, and dental;

8 (b) \$4,027 for short-term disability;

9 (c) \$118,437 for amortization equalization disbursement;

10 (d) \$118,437 for supplemental amortization equalization  
11 disbursement;

12 (e) \$319,020 for the purchase of legal services; and

13 (f) \$240,590 for the purchase of information technology services.

14 (2) For the 2021-22 state fiscal year, \$3,179,861 is appropriated  
15 to the department of public health and environment for use by the air  
16 pollution control division. This appropriation is from the general fund. To  
17 implement this act, the division may use this appropriation as follows:

18 (a) \$2,089,072 for personal services related to stationary sources,  
19 which amount is based on an assumption that the division will require an  
20 additional 31.0 FTE; and

21 (b) \$1,090,789 for operating expenses related to stationary sources.

22 (3) For the 2021-22 state fiscal year, \$319,020 is appropriated to  
23 the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds

1 received from the department of public health and environment under  
2 subsection (1)(e) of this section and is based on an assumption that the  
3 department of law will require an additional 1.7 FTE. To implement this  
4 act, the department of law may use this appropriation to provide legal  
5 services for the department of public health and environment.

6 (4) For the 2021-22 state fiscal year, \$240,590 is appropriated to  
7 the office of the governor for use by the office of information technology.  
8 This appropriation is from reappropriated funds received from the  
9 department of public health and environment under subsection (1)(f) of  
10 this section. To implement this act, the office may use this appropriation  
11 to provide information technology services for the department of public  
12 health and environment.

13 (5) For the 2021-22 state fiscal year, \$88,351 is appropriated to  
14 the office of the governor for use by the Colorado energy office. This  
15 appropriation is from the general fund and is based on an assumption that  
16 the office will require an additional 0.9 FTE. To implement this act, the  
17 office may use this appropriation for program costs."

18 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

19 Page 1, line 103, strike "GASES AND" and substitute "GASES,".

20 Page 1, line 105, strike "COMMUNITIES." and substitute "COMMUNITIES,  
21 AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.".

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
