Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB22-1115 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 8, strike lines 21 through 24 and substitute  
2 "ASSEMBLY SHALL TRANSFER TWO MILLION DOLLARS AND FORTY-FIVE  
3 THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED NINETY-EIGHT DOLLARS FOR THE  
4 ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS OF THIS SUBSECTION (7) FROM THE GENERAL FUND  
5 TO THE PRESCRIPTION DRUG MONITORING FUND CREATED IN SECTION  
6 12-280-405. THE DIVISION MAY USE THE MONEY TRANSFERRED TO THE  
7 PRESCRIPTION DRUG MONITORING FUND PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION  
8 (7) FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SUBSECTION (7). ANY MONEY  
9 TRANSFERRED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION (7) NOT EXPENDED PRIOR  
10 TO JULY 1, 2023, SHALL REMAIN IN THE FUND FOR THE SAME PURPOSE  
11 THROUGH DECEMBER 30, 2024."

12 Page 8, after line 25 insert:

13 **"SECTION 10. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2022-23 state fiscal  
14 year, \$2,045,198 is appropriated to the department of regulatory agencies  
15 for use by the division of professions and occupations. This appropriation  
16 is from the division of professions and occupations cash fund created in  
17 section 12-20-105 (3), C.R.S. Any money appropriated in this section not  
18 expended prior to July 1, 2023, is further appropriated to the division  
19 through December 30, 2024 for the same purpose. To implement this act,  
20 the division may use this appropriation as follows:

- 21 (a) \$45,198 for personal services; and
- 22 (b) \$2,000,000 for electronic medical records assistance."

23 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

24 Page 1, line 101, strike "PROGRAM." and substitute "PROGRAM, AND, IN  
25 CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION."
