Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB22-1315 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 3, line 8, strike "TWO" and substitute "ONE".
- 2 Page 3, strike lines 23 through 27.
- 3 Page 4, strike line 1.
- 4 Reletter succeeding paragraph accordingly.
- 5 Page 5, after line 8 insert:

6 **"SECTION 3. Appropriation.** For the 2021-22 state fiscal year,
7 \$1,000,000 is appropriated to the department of human services for use
8 by administration and finance. This appropriation is from the general
9 fund. To implement this act, administration and finance may use this
10 appropriation for grants for operational expenses related to the Colorado
11 2-1-1 collaborative. Any money appropriated in this section not expended
12 prior to July 1, 2022, is further appropriated to administration and finance
13 for the 2022-23 state fiscal year for the same purpose.

14 **SECTION 4. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2022-23 state fiscal
15 year, \$1,055,645 is appropriated to the department of human services for
16 use by administration and finance. This appropriation is from the general
17 fund. Any money appropriated in this section not expended prior to July
18 1, 2023, is further appropriated to administration and finance for the
19 2023-24 state fiscal year for the same purpose. To implement this act,
20 administration and finance may use this appropriation as follows:

21 (a) \$55,645 for the Colorado 2-1-1 collaborative, which amount
22 is based on an assumption that the department will require an additional
23 0.9 FTE; and

1 (b) \$1,000,000 for grants for operational expenses related to the
2 Colorado 2-1-1 collaborative."

3 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

4 Page 1, line 105, strike "SYSTEM." and substitute "SYSTEM AND MAKING
5 AN APPROPRIATION."
