(3) THE OFFICE SHALL DEVELOP A METHOD FOR BILLING USERS OF THE OFFICE'S SERVICES THE FULL COST OF THE SERVICES, INCLUDING MATERIALS, DEPRECIATION RELATED TO CAPITAL COSTS, LABOR, AND

OFFICE TO PAY THE DIRECT AND INDIRECT COSTS, INCLUDING PERSONAL
