- 6 Page 4, line 5, strike "DISORDERS." and substitute "DISORDERS, INCLUDING
- 7 TREATMENT WITH LONG-ACTING INJECTABLE MEDICINES, WHERE
- 8 CLINICALLY APPROPRIATE AND WHERE ADHERENCE TO MEDICATIONS HAS
- 9 BEEN A SIGNIFICANT CONTRIBUTING FACTOR IN THE DEFENDANT'S
- 10 ARRESTING CHARGES. IF THE DEFENDANT IS CURRENTLY HOUSED IN A JAIL
- OR CORRECTIONAL FACILITY, ONLY A LICENSED PHARMACIST OR OTHER
- 12 HEALTH-CARE PROVIDER MAY INJECT SUCH INJECTABLE MEDICINES, NOT
