Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB22-159 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 13, strike line 16 and substitute:

2 "(d) ON JULY 1, 2022,".

3 Page 13, line 18, after "DOLLARS" insert "FROM THE AFFORDABLE
4 HOUSING AND HOME OWNERSHIP CASH FUND CREATED IN SECTION
5 24-75-229 (3)(a) THAT ORIGINATES FROM THE GENERAL FUND,".

6 Page 13, lines 26 and 27, strike "SUBSECTION (9)(c) OF THIS SECTION" and
7 substitute "THIS SUBSECTION (9)(d)".

8 Page 15, after line 7 insert:

9 "SECTION 5. Appropriation. (1) For the 2022-23 state fiscal
10 year, \$379,081 is appropriated to the office of the governor for use by the
11 office of information technology. This appropriation is from
12 reappropriated funds received from the department of local affairs from
13 the transformational affordable housing revolving loan fund created in
14 section 24-32-726 (9)(a), C.R.S., that originate from the general fund, and
15 is based on an assumption that the office of information technology will
16 require an additional 4.3 FTE. To implement this act, the office may use
17 this appropriation to provide information technology services for the
18 department of local affairs."

19 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

20 Page 1, line 104, strike "HOUSING." and substitute "HOUSING, AND, IN
21 CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION."
