SB22-212 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 48, before line 23 insert:
- 2 "SECTION 106. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 17-42-103,
- 3 amend (5)(d) as follows:
- 4 **17-42-103. Policies concerning inmates' use of telephones -**
- 5 **excessive rates prohibited - transparency of communications services**
- 6 **in correctional facilities - report - definitions.** (5) (d) Penal
- 7 communications service providers shall include the following language
- 8 prominently on their website: "The public utilities commission (PUC)
- 9 gives consumers the opportunity to file informal complaints about
- 10 problems with the communications services that the PUC regulates.
- 11 Complaints can be filed through www.puc.colorado.gov"
- 12 [HTTPS://PUC.COLORADO.GOV](https://puc.colorado.gov)".
- 13 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.
- 14 Page 49, strike line 6 and substitute:
- 15 "(2) (a) Section 31 of this act takes effect only if House Bill
- 16 22-1278 does not become law.
- 17 (b) Section 86 of this act takes effect only if House Bill 22-1242
- 18 does not become law.
- 19 (c) Section 99 of this act takes effect only if House Bill".
- 20 Reletter succeeding paragraphs accordingly.

- 22 Page 49, line 13, strike "102" and substitute "103".
- 23 Page 49, line 16, strike "103" and substitute "104".
