<u>HB23-1205</u> be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on <u>Appropriations</u> with favorable recommendation:

2 "(d) An ombudsman is not adversarial and does not perform 3 investigations. An ombudsman does not replace the roles of the relevant 4 investigatory bodies, such as the Commission on Judicial Discipline, but 5 instead provides resources for complainants to access those investigatory 6 bodies.".

 INVOLVED IN THE COMPLAINT.".
