Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB23-016 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 12, line 18, strike "AN" and substitute "A".

2 Page 19, after line 7 insert:

3 "(d) THE QUALIFIED RETAILER MAY RETAIN FROM THE CREDIT
4 ALLOWED IN THIS SECTION AN ADMINISTRATIVE FEE NOT TO EXCEED THREE
5 PERCENT OF THE PURCHASE PRICE OF THE NEW, ELECTRIC-POWERED LAWN
6 EQUIPMENT SOLD."

7 Reletter succeeding paragraph accordingly.

8 Page 19, strike lines 17 through 21 and substitute:

9 "(II) BEFORE SELLING A PIECE OF NEW, ELECTRIC-POWERED
10 LAWN".

11 Page 21, strike lines 13 through 19.

12 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

13 Page 29, before line 22 insert:

14 "**SECTION 22.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 40-42-104, **add**
15 (4.5) as follows:

16 "**40-42-104. General and specific powers and duties of the**
17 **authority.** (4.5) ON AND AFTER JULY 1, 2024, THE AUTHORITY SHALL
18 OPERATE ON A FISCAL YEAR THAT ALIGNS WITH THE STATE FISCAL YEAR."

1 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

2 Page 32, strike lines 11 through 27 and substitute:

3 **"SECTION 26. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2023-24 state fiscal
4 year, \$338,270 is appropriated to the department of natural resources for
5 use by the oil and gas conservation commission. This appropriation is
6 from the oil and gas conservation and environmental response fund
7 created in section 34-60-122 (5)(a), C.R.S. To implement this act, the
8 commission may use this appropriation as follows:

9 (a) \$317,122 for program costs, which amount is based on an
10 assumption that the commission will require an additional 3.2 FTE; and

11 (b) \$21,148 for legal services.

12 (2) For the 2023-24 state fiscal year, \$14,706 is appropriated to
13 the department of public health and environment for use by the air
14 pollution control division. This appropriation is from the general fund,
15 and is based on an assumption that the division will require an additional
16 0.2 FTE. To implement this act, the division may use this appropriation
17 for personal services related to stationary sources.

18 (3) For the 2023-24 state fiscal year, \$34,052 is appropriated to
19 the department of revenue. This appropriation is from the general fund.
20 To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation as
21 follows:

22 (a) \$7,392 for use by taxation services for operating expenses; and

23 (b) \$26,660 for tax administration IT system (GenTax) support.

24 (4) For the 2023-24 state fiscal year, \$21,148 is appropriated to
25 the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds
26 received from the department of natural resources under subsection (1)(b)
27 of this section and is based on an assumption that the department of law
28 will require an additional 0.1 FTE. To implement this act, the department
29 of law may use this appropriation to provide legal services for the
30 department of natural resources."

31 Page 33, strike lines 1 through 21.

32 Page 33, strike line 23 and substitute "This act takes".

33 Page 34, strike lines 5 through 10.

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
