After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB23-094 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend the reengrossed bill, page 6, strike line 18 and substitute
- 2 "PROVIDERS. ONE MEMBER MUST REPRESENT A BUSINESS THAT
- 3 TRANSPORTS STUDENTS AS DESCRIBED PURSUANT TO SECTION 40-10.1-105
- 4 (1)(b) AND IS REGULATED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, AND ONE
- 5 MEMBER MUST BE REGULATED BY THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION."

- 6 Page 7, line 25 strike "PRESENT" and substitute "PRESENT, AT A
- 7 MINIMUM,".

- 8 Page 8, line 3, strike "SCHOOL OF CHOICE;" and substitute "SCHOOL
- 9 DISTRICT-ASSIGNED NEIGHBORHOOD PUBLIC SCHOOL, PUBLIC SCHOOL OF
- 10 CHOICE, OR CAREER PATHWAYS PROGRAM;".

- 11 Page 8, line 10, after "ROUTES," insert "DRIVER PAY RATES, HOURS OF
- 12 OPERATION, VACANCIES,".

- 13 Page 9, line 3, strike "SCHOOL OF THEIR CHOICE;" and substitute "SCHOOL
- 14 DISTRICT-ASSIGNED NEIGHBORHOOD PUBLIC SCHOOL, PUBLIC SCHOOL OF
- 15 CHOICE,".

- 16 Page 9, line 24, strike "EFFICIENCIES;" and substitute "EFFICIENCIES,
- 17 WHILE MAINTAINING SAFETY STANDARDS;".

- 18 Page 10, line 5, strike "AND".

- 19 Page 10, after line 5, insert:

- 20 "(j) AN ANALYSIS OF THE COSTS AND BENEFITS ASSOCIATED WITH

1 REQUIRING ROUTE SCHOOL BUSES THAT CAN CONTROL TRAFFIC WITH
2 ALTERNATING FLASHING RED LIGHTS TO HAVE AUTOMATED VEHICLE
3 INFORMATION SYSTEMS, AS DEFINED AT SECTION 42-4-110.5 (6), TO
4 RECORD MOTOR VEHICLES THAT UNLAWFULLY PASS A STOPPED ROUTE
5 SCHOOL BUS; AND".

6 Reletter succeeding paragraph accordingly.

7 Page 10, line 7, strike "TRANSPORTATION." and substitute
8 "TRANSPORTATION, WHILE PROTECTING PUBLIC FUNDS WITH CLEAR
9 ACCOUNTABILITY AND TRANSPARENCY."

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
