Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB23-189 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 14, before line 5 insert:

2 "SECTION 13. **Appropriation.** (1) For the 2023-24 state fiscal
3 year, \$1,000,000 is appropriated to the department of public health and
4 environment for use by the prevention services division. This
5 appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this act, the division
6 may use this appropriation for the reproductive privacy affordability grant
7 program related to women's health.

8 (2) For the 2023-24 state fiscal year, \$67,627 is appropriated to
9 the department of regulatory agencies. This appropriation is from the
10 division of insurance cash fund created in section 10-1-103 (3), C.R.S. To
11 implement this act, the division may use this appropriation as follows:

12 (a) \$37,109 for use by the division of insurance for personal
13 services, which amount is based on an assumption that the division will
14 require an additional 0.5 FTE;

15 (b) \$7,345 for use by the division of insurance for operating
16 expenses; and

17 (c) \$23,263 for the purchase of legal services.

18 (3) For the 2023-24 state fiscal year, \$23,263 is appropriated to
19 the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds
20 received from the department of regulatory agencies under subsection
21 (2)(c) of this section and is based on an assumption that the department
22 of law will require an additional 0.1 FTE. To implement this act, the
23 department of law may use this appropriation to provide legal services for
24 the department of regulatory agencies."

25 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.
