After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB24-1135 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Finance with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 3, strike lines 17 through 27.

2 Strike pages 4 through 11.

3 Page 12, strike lines 1 through 14 and substitute:

4 "SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 43-2-145, **add** (2.1)  
5 as follows:

6 **43-2-145. Transportation legislation review - committee -**  
7 **definition - repeal.** (2.1) (a) DURING THE 2024 LEGISLATIVE INTERIM,  
8 THE COMMITTEE SHALL ANALYZE THE ISSUE OF ENFORCEMENT OF  
9 IMPAIRED DRIVING OFFENSES, INCLUDING SITUATIONS INVOLVING A  
10 DRIVER WHO REFUSES TO TAKE OR COMPLETE A BLOOD OR BREATH TEST  
11 AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

12 (b) THE COMMITTEE MAY REQUEST AND RECEIVE INPUT FROM THE  
13 COLORADO STATE PATROL AND THE COLORADO TASK FORCE ON DRUNK  
14 AND IMPAIRED DRIVING CREATED IN SECTION 42-4-1306 AND TAKE  
15 TESTIMONY FROM INTERESTED OR KNOWLEDGEABLE PEOPLE ABOUT THE  
16 ISSUE OF ENFORCEMENT OF IMPAIRED DRIVING OFFENSES AND MAY  
17 OTHERWISE RESEARCH THE ISSUE.

18 (c) THE COMMITTEE MAY MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS CONCERNING  
19 THE ISSUE OF ENFORCEMENT OF IMPAIRED DRIVING OFFENSES DESCRIBED  
20 IN THIS SUBSECTION (2.1) TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, AND, IF THE  
21 COMMITTEE RECOMMENDS LEGISLATION, THE LEGISLATION IS TREATED AS  
22 LEGISLATION RECOMMENDED BY AN INTERIM LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE  
23 FOR PURPOSES OF ANY INTRODUCTION DEADLINES OR BILL LIMITATIONS  
24 IMPOSED BY THE JOINT RULES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

25 (d) THIS SUBSECTION (2.1) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2025."
