A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING STATUTORY DEFINITIONS RELATED TO HUMAN BEINGS TO

102 INCLUDE EVERY INFANT HUMAN BEING WHO IS BORN ALIVE AT

103 ANY STAGE OF DEVELOPMENT.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill defines, for the purposes of all statutes, "child", "human being", "individual", and "person" as every infant human being who is born alive at any stage of development. The bill defines "born alive" as, with respect to a human being, the complete expulsion or extraction from its mother a member of the species homo sapiens, at any stage of development, who after such expulsion or extraction breathes or has a beating heart, pulsation of the umbilical cord, or definite movement of voluntary muscles, regardless of whether the umbilical cord has been cut and regardless of whether the expulsion or extraction occurs as a result of natural or induced labor, cesarean section, or induced abortion.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-4-401, amend (1) 3 and (8); and **add** (1.2), (3.6), and (3.8) as follows: 4 **2-4-401. Definitions.** The following definitions apply to every 5 statute, unless the context otherwise requires: 6 (1) (a) "Child" includes child by adoption "BORN ALIVE", WITH 7 RESPECT TO A HUMAN BEING, AND AS USED IN THIS SECTION, INCLUDES THE 8 COMPLETE EXPULSION OR EXTRACTION FROM ITS MOTHER A MEMBER OF 9 THE SPECIES HOMO SAPIENS, AT ANY STAGE OF DEVELOPMENT, WHO AFTER 10 SUCH EXPULSION OR EXTRACTION BREATHES OR HAS A BEATING HEART, 11 PULSATION OF THE UMBILICAL CORD, OR DEFINITE MOVEMENT OF 12 VOLUNTARY MUSCLES, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THE UMBILICAL CORD 13 HAS BEEN CUT AND REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THE EXPULSION OR 14 EXTRACTION OCCURS AS A RESULT OF NATURAL OR INDUCED LABOR, 15 CESAREAN SECTION, OR INDUCED ABORTION. 16 (b) NOTHING IN THIS SUBSECTION (1) SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO 17 AFFIRM, DENY, EXPAND, OR CONTRACT ANY LEGAL STATUS OR LEGAL 18 RIGHT APPLICABLE TO ANY MEMBER OF THE SPECIES HOMO SAPIENS AT 19 ANY POINT PRIOR TO BEING BORN ALIVE AS DEFINED IN THIS SUBSECTION

21 (1.2) "CHILD" INCLUDES EVERY INFANT HUMAN BEING WHO IS

(3.6) "HUMAN BEING" INCLUDES EVERY INFANT HUMAN BEING

4 ALIVE AT ANY STAGE OF DEVELOPMENT.

(8) "Person" means any individual, corporation, government or
governmental subdivision or agency, business trust, estate, trust, limited
liability company, partnership, association, or other legal entity.
"PERSON", WHEN REFERRING TO HUMAN BEINGS, INCLUDES EVERY INFANT
HUMAN BEING WHO IS BORN ALIVE AT ANY STAGE OF DEVELOPMENT.

10 SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 11 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 12 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 13 10, 2016, if adjournment sine die is on May 11, 2016); except that, if a 14 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the 15 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act 16 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect 17 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 18 November 2016 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the 19 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
