A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING THE ISSUANCE OF A STANDARD LICENSE PLATE FOR A**
102 **MOTOR VEHICLE TO A PERSON WHO HAS BEEN ISSUED A**
103 **MILITARY LICENSE PLATE, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH,**
104 **MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.**

Bill Summary

The bill allows a person who has a special license plate for veterans to exchange it for a standard number plate without charge.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-3-213, **add** (1) (b)
3 (VI) as follows:

4 **42-3-213. License plates - military veterans - rules -**
5 **retirement.** (1) (b) (VI) A PERSON WHO HAS BEEN ISSUED A SPECIAL
6 LICENSE PLATE UNDER THIS SECTION MAY EXCHANGE THE PLATE FOR A
7 STANDARD NUMBER PLATE ISSUED UNDER SECTION 42-3-201 WITHOUT
8 PAYING ANY ADDITIONAL TAXES AND FEES FOR THE CURRENT
9 REGISTRATION PERIOD; EXCEPT THAT THE PERSON MUST PAY THE FEE
10 IMPOSED IN SECTION 42-3-301.

11 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-3-218, **add** (7) as
12 follows:

13 **42-3-218. Special plates - active and retired members of the**
14 **Colorado National Guard - retirement.** (7) A PERSON WHO HAS BEEN
15 ISSUED A SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE UNDER THIS SECTION MAY EXCHANGE
16 THE PLATE FOR A STANDARD NUMBER PLATE ISSUED UNDER SECTION
17 42-3-201 WITHOUT PAYING ANY ADDITIONAL TAXES AND FEES FOR THE
18 CURRENT REGISTRATION PERIOD; EXCEPT THAT THE PERSON MUST PAY THE
19 FEE IMPOSED IN SECTION 42-3-301.

20 **SECTION 3. Appropriation.** For the 2016-17 state fiscal year,
21 \$560 is appropriated to the department of revenue. This appropriation is
22 from the license plate cash fund created in section 42-3-301 (1) (b),
23 C.R.S. To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation
24 for license plate ordering.

25 **SECTION 4. Act subject to petition - effective date -**
26 **applicability.** (1) This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following

1 the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the
2 general assembly (August 10, 2016, if adjournment sine die is on May 11,
3 2016); except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1
4 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section,
5 or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part
6 will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election
7 to be held in November 2016 and, in such case, will take effect on the
8 date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.

9 (2) This act applies to license plate applications made on or after
10 January 1, 2017.
