# A BILL FOR AN ACT

101	CONCERNING THE STANDARDS APPLICABLE TO DOCUMENTS USED BY
102	WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE CARRIERS IN
103	COLORADO, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, REQUIRING
104	ADVISORY ORGANIZATIONS AND RATING ORGANIZATIONS TO
105	FILE SAMPLE FORMS OF POLICIES, RIDERS, LETTERS, NOTICES,
106	AND OTHER DOCUMENTS TO THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE.

#### **Bill Summary**

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Under current law, a workers' compensation insurer must annually

submit sample forms of policies, riders, letters, notices, and other documents used in its business to the commissioner of insurance along with a certification by an officer of the insurer that the documents comply with Colorado law. The bill extends these requirements to advisory organizations and rating organizations within the industry. It also relieves a carrier of the obligation to file such documents and certifications if it uses, without modification, the documents supplied by an advisory organization or rating organization.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

2 SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 8-44-102, amend (2)
3 as follows:

4 8-44-102. Contract for insurance subject to workers' 5 compensation act. (2) (a) (I) EXCEPT AS SPECIFIED IN SUBPARAGRAPH 6 (III) OF THIS PARAGRAPH (a), every carrier providing workers' 7 compensation insurance that is authorized to conduct business in 8 Colorado shall submit an annual report to the commissioner of insurance 9 listing any policy forms endorsements, riders, letters, notices, or other 10 documents affecting an insurance policy or contract issued or delivered 11 to any policyholder in Colorado as may be requested by the 12 commissioner. The listing must be submitted no later than July 1 of each 13 year and must contain a certification by an officer of the carrier that, to 14 the best of the officer's knowledge, each policy form endorsement, rider, 15 letter, notice, or other document affecting an insurance policy or contract 16 in use complies with Colorado law. The commissioner shall determine the 17 necessary elements of the certification.

(II) (<u>A</u>) AN ADVISORY ORGANIZATION AS DEFINED IN SECTION
10-4-402 (1), C.R.S., OR A RATING ORGANIZATION AS DEFINED IN SECTION
10-4-402 (3), C.R.S., SHALL SUBMIT AN ANNUAL REPORT TO THE
COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE LISTING ANY POLICY FORMS AS MAY BE

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<u>REQUESTED BY THE</u> COMMISSIONER. THE LISTING MUST BE SUBMITTED NO
 LATER THAN JULY 1 OF EACH YEAR AND MUST CONTAIN A CERTIFICATION
 BY AN OFFICER OF THE ORGANIZATION THAT, TO THE BEST OF THE
 OFFICER'S KNOWLEDGE, <u>EACH POLICY FORM LISTED</u> COMPLIES WITH
 COLORADO LAW. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL DETERMINE THE NECESSARY
 ELEMENTS OF THE CERTIFICATION.

7 (B) As used in this section, "Form" MAY INCLUDE ANY
8 ENDORSEMENT, RIDER, LETTER, NOTICE, OR OTHER DOCUMENT AFFECTING
9 AN INSURANCE POLICY OR CONTRACT ISSUED OR DELIVERED TO ANY
10 POLICYHOLDER IN COLORADO.

11 (III) IF A CARRIER USES, IN THEIR ENTIRETY AND WITHOUT 12 MODIFICATION, FORMS PREPARED BY AN ADVISORY ORGANIZATION AS 13 DEFINED IN SECTION 10-4-402 (1), C.R.S., OR A RATING ORGANIZATION AS 14 DEFINED IN SECTION 10-4-402 (3), C.R.S., THE CARRIER SHALL NOTIFY THE 15 COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE THAT IT ADOPTS THE ANNUAL REPORT FILED 16 BY THE ADVISORY ORGANIZATION OR RATING ORGANIZATION UNDER 17 SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH (a) AND, IF IT SO NOTIFIES THE 18 COMMISSIONER, IT NEED NOT SUBMIT THE CERTIFICATION REQUIRED BY 19 SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH (a). IF A CARRIER USES FORMS 20 THAT DEVIATE FROM THE FORMS LISTED BY THE ADVISORY ORGANIZATION 21 OR RATING ORGANIZATION, OR IF IT USES FORMS OTHER THAN THOSE 22 LISTED BY THE ADVISORY ORGANIZATION OR RATING ORGANIZATION, THE 23 CARRIER SHALL SUBMIT THE ANNUAL LISTING OF FORMS AND 24 CERTIFICATION AS REQUIRED BY SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH 25 (a).

(b) IN ADDITION TO SUBMITTING THE DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED
 UNDER PARAGRAPH (a) OF THIS SUBSECTION (2) AND EXCEPT AS SPECIFIED

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1 IN SUBPARAGRAPH (III) OF THIS PARAGRAPH (b):

2 (I) Every carrier providing workers' compensation insurance that 3 is authorized to conduct business in Colorado, EVERY ADVISORY 4 ORGANIZATION AS DEFINED IN SECTION 10-4-402 (1), C.R.S., AND EVERY 5 RATING ORGANIZATION AS DEFINED IN SECTION 10-4-402(3), C.R.S., shall 6 also submit to the commissioner a list of any new policy forms endorsements, riders, letters, notices, or other documents as may be 7 8 requested by the commissioner at least thirty-one days before using A 9 CARRIER USES the policy forms. endorsements, riders, letters, notices, or 10 other documents.

(II) The listing must also contain a certification by an officer of
the carrier OR AN OFFICER OF THE ADVISORY OR RATING ORGANIZATION
that, to the best of the officer's knowledge, each new policy form,
endorsement, rider, letter, notice, or other document proposed to be used
complies with Colorado law. The commissioner shall determine the
necessary elements of the certification.

(III) IF AN ADVISORY ORGANIZATION OR RATING ORGANIZATION
CERTIFIES A FORM AS REQUIRED BY SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS
PARAGRAPH (b) AND A CARRIER IS A MEMBER OF THAT ORGANIZATION AND
USES THE FORM IN ITS ENTIRETY, THE CARRIER NEED NOT LIST THAT FORM
AS REQUIRED BY SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH (b) OR SUBMIT
A CERTIFICATION FOR THAT FORM AS REQUIRED BY SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF
THIS PARAGRAPH (b).

(c) The commissioner may examine and investigate workers'
 compensation carriers authorized to conduct business in Colorado to
 <u>determine whether workers' compensation policy forms endorsements</u>,
 <del>riders, letters, notices, or other forms</del> as may be requested by the

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- 1 commissioner comply with the certification of the carrier and statutory
- 2 <u>mandates.</u>
- 3 SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
  4 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
  5 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
