**Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause.

**Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$114,188 cash funds from the Colorado Bureau of Investigation Identification Unit Fund to the Department of Public Safety for FY 2016-17. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 0.6 FTE. The amendment also adds a provision appropriating a total of \$32,342 cash funds from the Division of Professions and Occupations Cash Fund to the Department of Regulatory Agencies for FY 2016-17. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 0.3 FTE. Finally, this provision provides \$15,202 reappropriated funds to the Department of Law for the provision of legal services and assumes that the Department will require an additional 0.1 FTE.
