Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates the following:

- \$114,188 cash fund from the from the Colorado Bureau of Investigation Identification Unit Fund to the Department of Public Safety for FY 2016-17;
- \$32,342 cash funds from the Division of Professions and Occupations Cash Fund to the Department of Regulatory Agencies for FY 2016-17; and
- \$15,202 reappropriated funds to the Department of Law for the provision of legal services.
