*General Fund Impact*

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2016-17 based on the March 2016 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its FY 2016-17 budget package a \$100,000 General Fund appropriation for implementation of this bill.
