Summary of Legislation

The bill creates a procedure at the Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV) in the Department of Revenue (DOR) where an undocumented resident who has qualified for a driver's license but has failed the driving test may use a private vendor to readminister the driving test within 60 days. The applicant must present evidence of passing the test to the DMV.

Background

The Colorado Road and Community Safety Act, Senate Bill 13-251, allows the state to issue a driver's license, minor's driver's license, instruction permit, or identification card to a noncitizen resident of Colorado who cannot provide proof of lawful presence in the United States. There are currently three offices that issue identity documents to individuals who cannot demonstrate lawful presence: Denver Central, Colorado Springs, and Grand Junction. Services for individuals who cannot demonstrate a lawful presence are by appointment only.

State Expenditures

The DOR will update its processes to accommodate the changes under the bill which represent a minimal increase in workload. To the extent that applicants take their follow up driving tests from third party vendors, the DMV will have a reduction in workload associated with giving driving tests.
