

Sunset Process - Senate Education Committee. The bill implements the recommendation of the department of regulatory agencies to continue the education data advisory committee.

2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, repeal
3	(4)(a)(VII) as follows:
4	2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees - legislative
5	declaration - definition - repeal. (4) (a) The following statutory
6	authorizations for the designated advisory committees will repeal on July
7	1, 2017:
8	(VII) The education data advisory committee created pursuant to
9	section 22-2-304, C.R.S.;
10	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-2-304, repeal (6)
11	as follows:
12	22-2-304. Education data advisory committee - creation -
13	duties. (6) (a) This section is repealed, effective July 1, 2017.
14	(b) Prior to such repeal, the EDAC shall be reviewed as provided
15	in section 2-3-1203, C.R.S.
16	SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
17	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
18	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
