As such, the appropriation contains amounts that correspond to centralized appropriation amounts in the Department of Human Services. Consistent with the headnotes to the Long Bill, the Department of Human Services is authorized to transfer the centralized appropriations to other line item appropriations in the Department of Human Services. In order to aid budget reconciliation between the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing and the Department of Human Services, the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing is hereby authorized to make line item transfers out of this appropriation to other Department of Human Services Medicaid-funded programs appropriations in this section (7) in amounts equal to the centralized appropriation transfers made by the Department of Human Services for Medicaid-funded programs in the Department of Human Services.

2	policy and financing for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016. In
3	Session Laws of Colorado 2016, amend section 40 of chapter 153, (HB

16	appropriation in subsection (1) of this section is based on the assumption
17	that the department will receive this amount of federal funds.
18	SECTION 3. Appropriation to the department of health care
19	policy and financing for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016. In
20	Session Laws of Colorado 2016, section 11 of chapter 270, (SB 16-199),
21	amend (1) as follows:
22	Section 11. Appropriation. (1) For the 2016-17 state fiscal year,
23	\$225,000 is appropriated to the department of health care policy and
24	financing for use by the executive director's office. This appropriation is
25	from the department of health care policy and financing cash fund created
26	in section 25.5-1-109, C.R.S. To implement this act, the executive
27	director's office may use this appropriation for general professional

25	(c) \$1,133,477 from recoveries and recoupments for the children's
26	basic health plan medical and dental costs; and
27	(d) \$154,208 from the general fund for the Medicare

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1	modernization act state contribution payment.
2	(2) In accordance with section 24-75-109(4)(a), C.R.S., all
3	restrictions on funds for the department of health care policy and
4	financing for the 2016-17 state fiscal year for the amounts and items of
5	appropriation listed in this section are released.
6	SECTION 5. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,

determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate

preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.

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
