CONCERNING THE CONTINUATION OF THE LOCAL ADVISORY BOARDS FOR VETERANS COMMUNITY LIVING CENTERS.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 26-12-121, **repeal** (3) as follows:

26-12-121. Veterans community living centers - local advisory boards - rules. (3) ~~(a) This section is repealed, effective July 1, 2017.~~

~~(b) Prior to repeal, the local advisory boards appointed pursuant to this section shall be reviewed as provided in section 2-3-1203, C.R.S.~~

SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, **repeal** (4)(a)(III) as follows:

2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees - legislative declaration - definition - repeal. (4) (a) The following statutory

authorizations for the designated advisory committees will repeal on July 1, 2017:

~~(III) Each of the local advisory boards for veterans community living centers created pursuant to section 26-12-121, C.R.S.;~~

SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
