Summary of Legislation

The bill exempts from regulation under the Pet Animal Care and Facilities Act:

- the boarding of no more than three pet animals at one time; and
- a company that uses technology in its business model that is not a pet animal facility.

State Expenditures

In FY 2017-18 only, the Inspection and Consumer Services Division of the Department of Agriculture will have a minimal workload increase to update its rules pertaining to the administration and enforcement of the Pet Animal Care and Facilities Act. This workload increase can be accomplished within existing appropriations.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor, and took effect June 5, 2017.
