Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill includes an appropriation clause that reduces General Fund appropriations to the Department of Corrections for FY 2017-18 by \$6,628,401 and increases General Fund appropriations to the Department of Local Affairs for FY 2017-18 by \$6,628,401, for a net General Fund change of \$0. The clause also appropriates a total of \$156,865 from reappropriated funds to the Departments of Law and to the Governor's Office of Information Technology (OIT). These appropriations correspond to the April 25th Legislative Council Staff revised fiscal note.
