A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING GRANTS TO PROVIDE EQUIPMENT TO RURAL FIRE**
102 **PROTECTION DISTRICTS.**

Bill Summary

The division of fire prevention and control in the department of public safety is currently authorized to use money in the local firefighter safety and disease prevention fund to provide grants for equipment and training to increase firefighter safety and prevent occupation-related diseases. The bill specifies that the fund may also be used to assist rural special fire protection districts in replacing or refurbishing equipment and

transfers \$500,000 from the general fund to be used for this purpose.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-1231, █

3 **add** (4) as follows:

4 **24-33.5-1231. Local firefighter safety and disease prevention**

5 **fund - creation - grants - rules.** (4) ON JULY 1, 2018, THE STATE

6 TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND █

7 DOLLARS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE FUND. THE DIVISION SHALL

8 USE THIS MONEY TO MAKE GRANTS UNDER SUBSECTION (2) OF THIS

9 SECTION. IN NO EVENT SHALL ANY INDIVIDUAL GRANT BE IN EXCESS OF

10 THE AMOUNT OF TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS.

11 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,

12 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate

13 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
