A BILL FOR AN ACT
CONCERNING AN EXTENSION OF THE REPEAL OF THE EARLY
CHILDHOOD AND SCHOOL READINESS LEGISLATIVE
COMMISSION, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN
APPROPRIATION.

Bill Summary

Early Childhood and School Readiness Legislative Commission. The bill extends the repeal date of the early childhood and school readiness legislative commission.

1	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, amend 26-6.5-204
3	as follows:
4	26-6.5-204. Repeal of part. This part 2 is repealed, effective July
5	1, 2018 2023.
6	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 26-6.5-203, amend
7	(2)(a) as follows:
8	26-6.5-203. Early childhood and school readiness legislative
9	commission - creation - membership - duties - funding. (2) (a) The
10	commission shall MAY meet at least four times annually; EXCEPT THAT
11	THE COMMISSION SHALL NOT MEET UNLESS THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
12	APPROVES MEETINGS DURING THE INTERIM PURSUANT TO SECTION
13	2-3-303.3 OR THE COMMISSION RECEIVES ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT FROM
14	A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION OR GOVERNMENT ENTITY. The commission
15	shall study issues concerning early childhood and school readiness.
16	including but not limited to health care, mental health, parental
17	involvement, family support, child care, and early learning. The
18	commission shall solicit input from members of the public, especially
19	those individuals with expertise related to early childhood and school
20	readiness issues, to aid the commission in its work. The commission shall
21	consult with the early childhood leadership commission, created in
22	section 26-6.2-103, with regard to policies concerning early childhood
23	and school readiness.
24	SECTION 3. Appropriation. (1) For the 2018-19 state fiscal
25	year, \$5,244 is appropriated to the legislative department. This
26	appropriation is from the general fund. The legislative department may
