The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates a total of \$1,401,432 General Fund to the Department of Corrections for FY 2020-21 through FY 2022-23.

General Fund Impact

This bill requires \$1,401,432 in statutory appropriations from the General Fund to the Department of Corrections from FY 2020-21 through FY 2022-23. These appropriations and transfers reduce the amount of General Fund available for other purposes.
