Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates \$175,000 General Fund to the Advanced Industries Export Acceleration Cash Fund for FY 2018-19. This provision also reappropriates \$175,000 from the Advanced Industries Export Acceleration Cash Fund to the Office of the Governor.

Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2018-19 based on the March 2018 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its FY 2018-19 budget package a \$175,000 General Fund appropriation for FY 2018-19 for implementation of this bill.
