Bill Topic: REMOVE TERM "PAUPER" FROM C.R.S.

Summary of Fiscal Impact: **No Fiscal Impact.** This bill updates statutory language to replace references to "paupers" as "indigent persons". It has no fiscal impact.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status: This fiscal note reflects the introduced bill, which was recommended by the Statutory Revision Committee.

Summary of Legislation

This bill updates language referring to a person who cannot afford to pay for their burial from "pauper" to "indigent person."

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

Updating statutory citations will have no impact on the expenditures or revenues of any state agency or local government, and, therefore, this bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect August 8, 2018, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 9, 2018, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
