## Summary of Legislation

The bill makes a FY 2017-18 transfer from the General Fund to the Capital Construction Fund.

## State Transfers

For FY 2017-18, the bill transfers \$2.9 million from the General Fund to the Information Technology (IT) Account in the Capital Construction Fund to pay the additional costs associated with one IT capital project.

## Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on March 1, 2018.
