### **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates \$200,000 General Fund to the Department of Education for FY 2018-19. However, as amended by the Senate Education Committee, the bill requires an appropriation of \$600,000 General Fund to the Teacher Residency Expansion Program Fund rather than \$200,000 appropriated directly to the Department of Education.

## **Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.002** Staff has prepared amendment **J.002** (attached) to change the existing clause to appropriate \$600,000 General Fund to the Teacher Residency Expansion Program Fund for FY 2018-19. Because the Teacher Residency Expansion Program Fund is continuously appropriated to the Department, no further appropriation out of the fund is necessary.

#### **Points to Consider**

#### General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2018-19 based on the March 2018 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its budget package \$8,000,000 General Fund set-aside for FY 2018-19 for Educator Preparation Programs in the Department of Education.
