**Points to Consider**

*Future Fiscal Impact*

This bill will reduce General Fund revenues by an estimated \$5.4 million in FY 2020-21 and \$10.8 million in FY 2021-22 and subsequent fiscal years through at least FY 2029-30, reducing the amount of General Fund available for other purposes.
