Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill includes an appropriation clause that provides an appropriation of \$123,465 General Fund to the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs for FY 2018-19. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 1.1 FTE.

General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2018-19 based on the March 2018 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its FY 2018-19 budget package a \$133,118 General Fund appropriation for FY 2018-19 for implementation of this bill.
