Bill Topic: REMOVE OBSOLETE DATE FROM STATE LEGAL HOLIDAY LAW

Summary of Fiscal Impact: **No Fiscal Impact.** This bill removes an obsolete date from the state's legal holiday law, and has no fiscal impact.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status: This fiscal note reflects the introduced bill, which was recommended by the Statutory Revision Committee.

Summary of Legislation

This bill removes the reference to the effective date of April 30, 1979, from the state's legal holiday law.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

Removing the obsolete date from statute will not impact the revenue, expenditures, or workload of any state agency or local government, and therefore, is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect August 8, 2018, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 9, 2018, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
