**AN ACT**

**CONCERNING CLARIFYING THAT THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AND DEFENSE COUNSEL EXEMPTION FOR SEXUAL EXPLOITATION OF A CHILD CRIME DOES NOT CHANGE THE DISCOVERY PROCEDURES FOR SEXUALLY EXPLOITATIVE MATERIAL.**

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

**SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 18-6-403, **add** (8) as follows:

**18-6-403. Sexual exploitation of a child - legislative declaration - definitions.**

(8) **NOTHING IN THIS SECTION CHANGES THE DISCOVERY PROCEDURE FOR SEXUALLY EXPLOITATIVE MATERIAL AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 16-9-601.**

**SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
